



Information provided to Applicants of Working Holiday Visa and the Youth Mobility Agreement

Registration in Germany:

It is compulsory to register with the local city/district council in Germany. You need to register within two weeks of moving into your accommodation. It is important that you have a confirmation from your landlord (Wohnungsgeberbestätigung). You will then receive a confirmation of registration by the council.

Insurance:

The visa allows you to work in Germany. Depending on the type and scope of your employment, national insurance contributions are compulsory in Germany. It is your responsibility to clarify this with your future employer for example. Above all, comprehensive health insurance may be required.

Self-employment:

Citizens of Andorra, Chile, Israel, Japan and Uruguay may also be self-employed or do freelance work. It is your responsibility to be informed on all obligations in connection with this. The following website provides further information on this topic: www.gewerbeanmeldung.de
